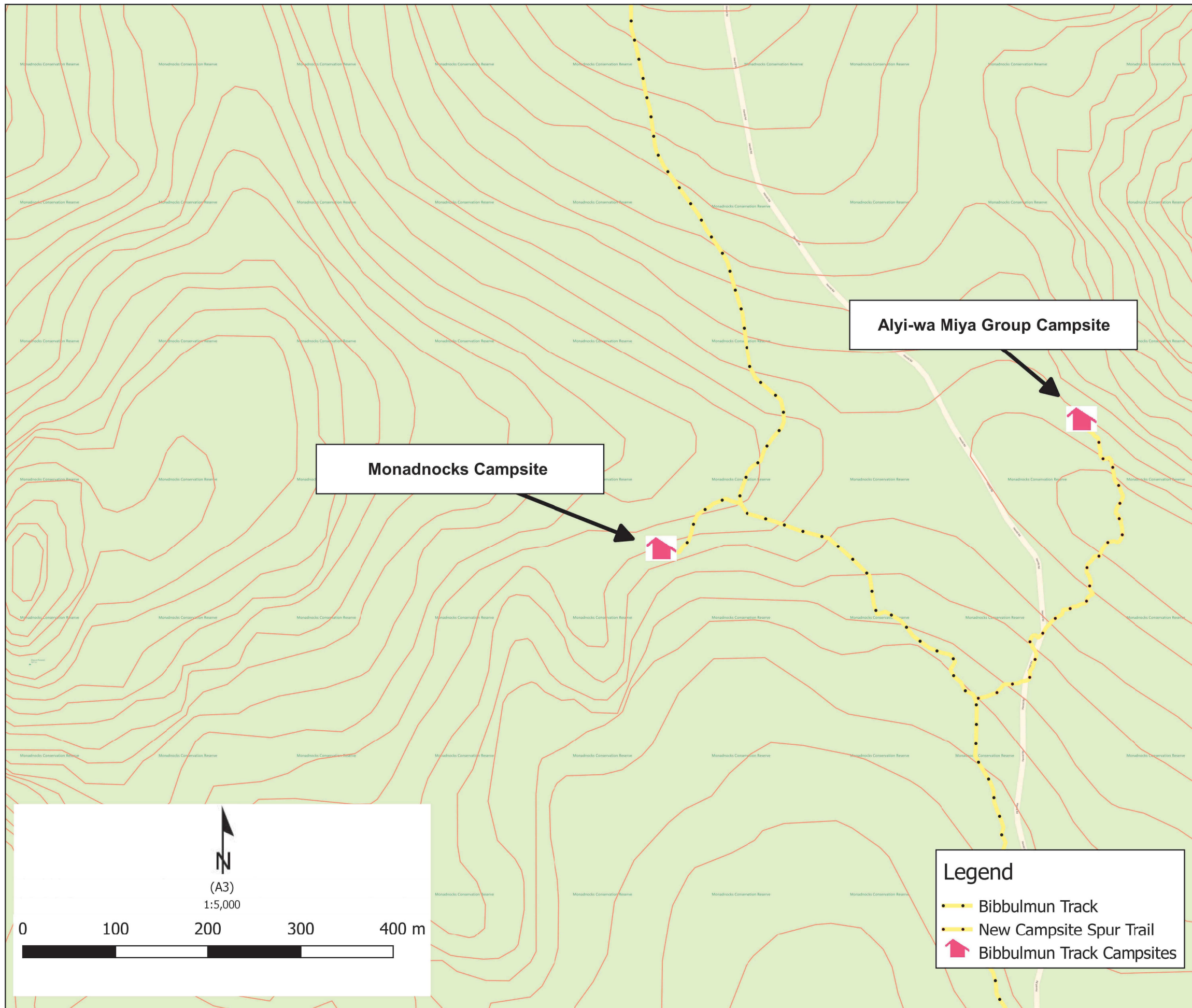
NEW GROUP CAMPSITE
