

BIBBULMUN TRACK

DENMARK NAVIGATION OPTIONS

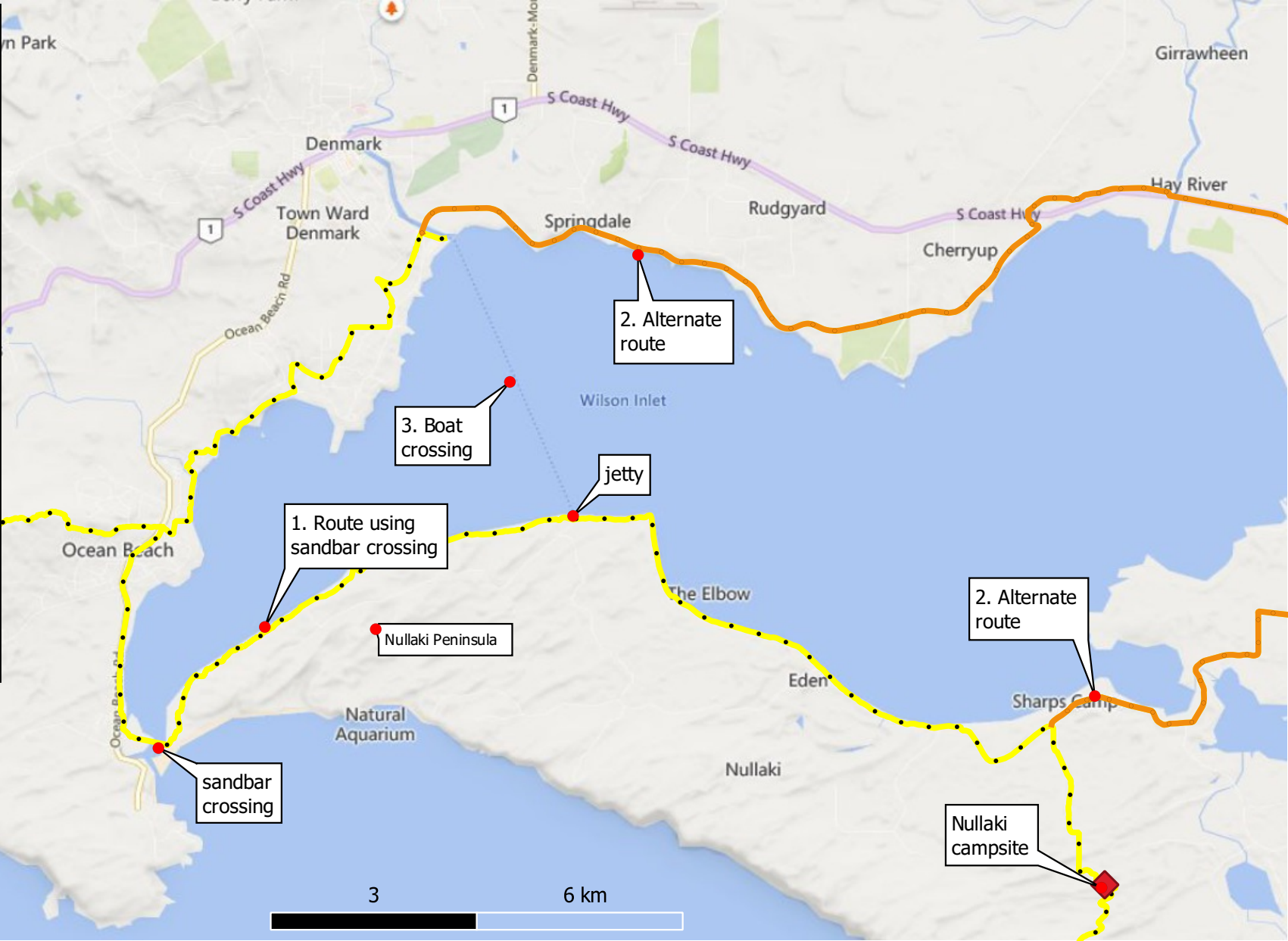
There are several options for Bibbulmun Track walkers in the Denmark and Wilson Inlet area, outlined below:

1. Follow the route that is now in place crossing the Wilson Inlet sandbar. This is only suitable when the sandbar is formed and there is no flow at the inlet mouth. The route is marked with standard Bibbulmun Track trail markers.
2. Follow the alternate route around Wilson Inlet, as shown on the Bibbulmun Track map. Note that this route does not have Bibbulmun Track marking.
3. Seek boat transport across the inlet.
4. Seek road transport around the inlet.

Walkers are advised to carefully consider the options before committing to a particular route.
