## NEW TRACK ROUTE

### Wilson Inlet Sandbar Crossing

A new route of the Bibbulmun Track is now established (shown in green on this map).

The route runs along Ocean Beach Rd and crosses the Wilson Inlet sandbar, then proceeds eastward along the Nullaki Peninsula to join the existing Bibbulmun Track.

The new route is approximately 10.6km.

Note that this route is only suitable when the sandbar is formed and there is no flow at the inlet mouth.
